C. Personal Interview

Only those candidates who are declared to have passed the Prelims/Screening Test and Mains (writter) Examination shall be eligible to appear for the Personal Interview. Ratio to be called for Personal Interview will be decided by the Meghalaya Rural Development Services Recruitment Board.

NOTE: Only candidates who have produced the required documents in original relating to their educational qualifications, experience, date of birth, caste/community and other certificates, wherever required and prescribed, will be deemed qualified to be called for the Personal interview.

6. Debarment
